Most of the selected hotels are within walking distance to the Congress venue. Rates do not include city tax, which is paid directly at the hotel during check-in.

PRACTICAL INFOMATION

If you're visiting Portugal or Porto for the first time, here are some key things to know:

1. Arrival & Transport

- Airport: Porto's Francisco Sá Carneiro Airport (OPO) is about 20 minutes from the city center by metro, taxi, or bus.
- Public Transport: The Metro do Porto is reliable, and buses and trams connect key areas.
- Taxis & Rideshares: Taxis are common, and apps like Bolt and Uber work well.
- Walking: Porto is hilly, so wear comfortable shoes!

2. Language & Communication

- **Portuguese** is the official language, but English is widely spoken in tourist areas.
- Learn a few basics:
 - o "Olá" (Hello)







- "Obrigado/a" (Thank you male/female)
- "Por favor" (Please)

3. Money & Payments

- Currency: Euro (€)
- Cards: Credit/debit cards are widely accepted, but some small cafés prefer cash.
- ATMs (Multibanco): Easy to find, but avoid the high-fee Euronet machines.

4. Safety & Emergencies

- Portugal is one of the safest countries in Europe, but beware of pickpockets in crowded areas.
- Emergency number: 112 (for police, ambulance, fire).
- Keep an eye on your belongings, especially in tourist hotspots.

5.Pharmacies

- Have a green cross sign
- Websites like Farmácias de Serviço allow you to search for nearby pharmacies and check their opening hours.

6. Food & Dining

- Try Francesinha (Porto's famous sandwich), Bacalhau (codfish), and Pastel de Nata (custard tart).
- **Tipping**: Not required, but rounding up or leaving **5-10%** is appreciated.
- **Dining times**: Lunch (12:30–3 PM), Dinner (7:30–10 PM).

7. Weather & Clothing

- In late May, Porto has pleasant spring weather, with temperatures around 15-25°C (59-77°F).
- It can be **sunny but occasionally rainy**, so bring a **light jacket and an umbrella** just in case
- Evenings can be **cooler**, so layering is a good idea.

8. Cultural Tips

- Portuguese people are **friendly and polite**. Greet with a handshake or two kisses (among friends).
- Queuing is informal—expect people to be relaxed about lines.

9. Shop Opening Hours in Porto

- Regular Shops: Open Monday to Friday, 9 AM 7 PM (some close for lunch from 1 PM 3 PM).
- Shopping Malls: Open daily, usually 10 AM 11 PM (no siesta).
- Supermarkets: Typically 8 AM 9 PM, some larger ones until midnight.
- Small Businesses: May close for lunch breaks (siesta-style) from 1 PM 3 PM.
- Sundays & Holidays: Many small shops close, but malls and supermarkets stay open.
- While Portugal doesn't have a strict "siesta" like Spain, some smaller local stores may close for a few hours in the afternoon, especially outside tourist areas.

Sheraton Porto Hotel & Spa is located in Porto's modern business district, 15 minutes by car or around 40 minutes on foot from the city centre

Here are a few ways to get there:

1. **By Car**: If you're driving, you can use a GPS or a map app to navigate to the address. The hotel offers on-site parking for €25 per day

2. By Public Transport:

- Metro: There's a direct metro route from Porto Airport to Sheraton Porto (Francos Station); You can reach the metro station walking 5 min from the arrivals terminal. The journey takes around 30 min and the ticket price is EUR 2.25 (zone Z4) plus the one time fee for the Metro Card (Andante) EUR 0,60. - Bus: Several bus lines stop near the hotel. You can check local bus routes for the most convenient option.
- 3. **By Taxi or Ride-Sharing**: The Porto airport taxi ride will take approximately 30 minutes into the city. On Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays (all day) and every day between 9 pm and 6 am, the rates increase 20%.

DISCOVERING GUIMARÃES TOUR – HALF DAY (MAY 29th, Thursday)

02.00 pm Departure from the Sheraton Porto & Hotel, for a half day tour to Guimães. Guimarães, a UNESCO World Heritage site and an ancient northern city, is known as the cradle or birthplace of Portugal, so its wealth of cultural heritage is hardly surprising. The city has a pleasant and well-preserved historic heritage, where the castle, as well as its medieval streets stand out.

There may not be much left inside the walls, but Guimarães Castle looks impressive from the outside. A magnificent bronze statue of Portugal's first king, Afonso Henriques, welcomes you into the castle grounds. You will also visit the Ducal Palace, built in Guimarães between 1420 and 1422. The imposing building is most noticeable for its abundance of tall red brick chimneys, which you can get a good view of from the castle battlements.







Enjoy a stroll through the charming streets of the well-preserved historical centre. Take some time to visit local shops and cafes and soak up the relaxed atmosphere.

The tour ends with a drop-off at the Sheraton Porto Hotel & Spa.

DISCOVERING DOURO TOUR - FULL DAY (MAY 30th, Friday)
